SYNOD UPDATE FROM THE DIOCESE

The Deanery Leadership Team is part of a Diocesan initiative to follow up on the work of the Synod. In this initiative, parishioners from our deanery will work together to set goals for our parish and deanery.

In phase one, the Eastern Shore Leadership team developed a survey that was distributed throughout the deanery parishes. Results of this survey identified focusing on youth, deepening spirituality, and building the community as primary issues. The next step is developing goals.
