November 9<sup>th</sup> @ 4:30pm (prior to Mass) there will be a Veterans Remembrance ceremony. All are invited to attend.


### **PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS**

Called by Name is a program to create a vocations culture where priests and people recognize potential candidates for priesthood and religious life and encourage them. On the weekend of November 3 and 4 we are asking priests to preach about encouraging vocations to the priesthood and religious life and to strengthen a culture in your parish where vocations are talked about, prayed for and encouraged. It is important and significant to acknowledge the gifts a young person possesses and how the Church needs them. Encouraging someone can make a difference and introduce them to the next step – a response.

Parishioners are asked to look around and nominate young people who they might see a vocation in. Then complete a card (yellow cards on the tables in the back of church) which means they will have to know their name. The parish should have the other information needed to invite them to a Holy Hour and discernment session. Cards should be returned on the weekend of November 9 and 10. The pastor will review them and return them to the Vocation Office.

Please pray for vocation during the week – National Vocation Awareness Week – November 3-10.
