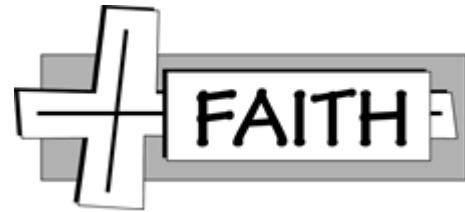

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Ezekiel 2:2-5

Gospel: Mark 6:1-6a

Everyday Stewardship

As the baptized, we are called into community, and we are strongest when all members have full faith in Jesus Christ.
